

CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 21 - OFFICIAL CITY NEWSPAPER
*A Charter Ordinance of the City of Quinter, Kansas designating an official city newspaper
and repealing any ordinance in conflict therewith.*

Be it ordained by the Governing Body of the City of Quinter as follows:

Section 1. REPEALS: Charter Ordinance No. 20 is hereby repealed.

Section 2. PURPOSE: The City of Quinter, Kansas, is required by K.S.A 12-1651 to designate annually by Resolution or Ordinance, a newspaper with general circulation in the county, to be the official newspaper.

Section 2. DESIGNATION: The governing body shall designate by naming, the Gove County Advocate, a newspaper published in Quinter, Gove County, Kansas, the Official City Newspaper of the City of Quinter.

Section 3. PUBLICATION: This charter ordinance shall be published once each week for two consecutive weeks in the newspaper, Gove County Advocate, generally circulating in Quinter, Kansas.

Section 4. EFFECTIVE: This charter ordinance shall take effect 61 days after its publication unless a sufficient petition for a referendum is filed, requiring a referendum to be held on the ordinance as provided by Article 12, Section 5, Subsection (c)(3) of the Constitution of the State of Kansas, in which case this charter ordinance shall become effective upon approval by the majority of the electors voting thereon.
